Here's what I have for the tweaked roundabouts. I moved the southern one out of the pond, and revised the lanes in the roundabouts. I'd like to discuss the tweaks I've made and some geometric options that there are for roundabouts.

Scott and I discussed the traffic report and bypass alignment. There is some question as to which would perform better, a single lane bypass without the lane merge (as shown previously), or the two-lane bypass that is being shown now. We could model the options and try to get a better feel for the friction present in each.

I didn't try to show right of way yet, as it seems like the widths will need to be determined after we have a plan for the utility relocations.

Attached is the Floridian Way traffic data that shows the current/existing conditions volumes and the future projected volumes (2035) with the outbound alignment. We have previously provided this to HNTB. Additionally we did an operational analysis for the Seven Seas roundabout (with the new Polynesian Connection). Those volumes that Kitteslon utilized are on page 3 of that document.

Kittelson's notes on the Seven Seas/Poly Entrance roundabout are as followed:

- We show about 60 vehicles making the movement in an hour (Seven Seas WB to Floridian Way NB).
- They will be conflicting with about 1,200 vehicles, so there is potential for delay on the Seven Seas approach our analysis shows 35 to 40 seconds for that approach – but within the roundabout there should not be any "weaving" or lane changing.
- The 95th percentile queue on the Seven Seas approach is projected to be 6 vehicles so nothing too concerning.

Sure, appreciate the opportunity to clarify ...

At present, our "preferred" direction as communicated to us through our leadership is to eliminate ALL pedestrian activity across Floridian Way (future 4-lane World Drive) generated by the Shades of Green resort. This will be accomplished by mandating guest usage of the shuttle bus AND development of site modifications / redesign of the space between the SoG Resort and Floridian Way to eliminate pedestrian activity altogether. The current direction

was communicated to our team on December 20th ahead of our meeting with you earlier this week where the District identified a number of challenges and other considerations with this approach. Our intent is to communicate these back to leadership so that they can understand the RCID position and the associated trade-offs. This is what I meant by "continuing to explore options" and the need to keep an open dialogue specifically for that location so that we can reach consensus.

We understand the District's concerns over the current configuration and the pedestrian activity that is associated with a crossing of Floridian Way. The goal is to create an entirely different future condition that eliminates the pedestrian mode and that linkage entirely. At this point, we can only speculate on how this will be accomplished but we acknowledge and understand the RCID position on the perceived need for removal of sidewalk, installation of fencing, and other means deemed necessary to prevent pedestrian crossing movements.

Based on my recollection of what was discussed Tuesday, the only way that RCID can accept an unsignalized intersection at that location is if there is either extensive fencing OR a grade-separated pedestrian crossing to accommodate any pedestrians that could end up at that location despite our efforts to redirect. Further, it was added that the risk associated with satisfying the pedestrian safety concerns is that the intersection could still require future signalization to accommodate the bus traffic and other larger vehicle movements from the minor approaches, particularly the Polynesian service leg. In a scenario where this is required, the signal would have otherwise satisfied the pedestrian movement without the added expense of extensive fencing and/or a grade-separated pedestrian conveyance.

That said, the CADD layout shared this morning is reflective of an approach we understand to be acceptable to RCID. It provides us a starting point for the next round of discussions with our leadership on how to respond to the current RCID concerns at this location.

We've also created an updated version of the roll plot showing the completed concept for Phases 2 an 3 together, along with an exhibit showing how a potential phasing of the southern roundabout might be incorporated with the Phase 2 effort by DRMP. As we discussed on Tuesday, it is understood that what we've shown here is all still in a conceptual stage, but we welcome the opportunity to work collaboratively with the District as details of the proposed geometrics are finalized to include consideration of utilities and other factors.

We believe you'll find this version to more-closely reflect the discussions around larger-diameter "momma bear" roundabouts and other details as informed by operational analyses and appropriate attention to applicable design criteria to establish the overall footprint. As we also discussed, we're continuing to explore options at the proposed intersection serving Shades of Green and the Polynesian service access, but this has been revised to provide a crosswalk of the north approach as implied by future signalization for the time being.
